CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hills Football and the community are fortunate to have Bella Vista Public School as a facility to use.

Bella Vista Public School is a brand new state of the art facility owned by the NSW Department of Education. Hills Football has hired this venue for your enjoyment however the venue comes with strict conditions of entry. The NSW Department of Education has officially warned Hills Football that should these regulations not be adhered to, it will shut down any events being played and will remove all users from its facility. The regulations include:

- Strictly ZERO tolerance on alcohol consumption
- Strictly ZERO tolerance on Smoking
- Strictly ZERO tolerance on Dogs or Pets within the facility
- Strictly ZERO tolerance of rubbish not placed in provided bins
- Strictly ZERO tolerance on anyone apart from players or coaches entering the artificial field surface

NO ALCOHOL

Alcohol must not be consumed or brought to the school premises. Anyone found consuming Alcohol will be asked to leave the premises. If the individual/s refuse to leave the Police will be called to address the situation.

NO SMOKING

Smoking on School premises, including school buildings, gardens, sport field and car park is prohibited. Anyone found to be smoking will be asked to stop/leave the premise.

NO DOGS

A special condition of entry is that NO DOGS are permitted within the school grounds. You will be asked to leave the premise with your dog/s.

Any team who does not comply with the above regulations will be removed from the competition with immediate effect.
